

Definition – Objective of functional Safety

The objective of Functional Safety is freedom from unacceptable risk of physical injury or of damage to the health of people either directly or indirectly (through damage to property or to the environment).

Policy goals

The goal is to ensure that the developed and manufactured equipment can operate safely in safety relevant applications.

Our policy is:

- Development and integration of a safety culture in all product development and service activities to recognize the importance and value of an effective Safety Management
- Clearly definition of responsibilities for the development, manufacturing and delivery of safety relevant products
- Actively development and improvement of the safety processes to ensure and to conform that international legislative and regulatory safety standards are fulfilled
- To ensure that all staff are provided with the adequate an appropriate safety information and training
- To ensure that sufficient skilled and trained resources are available to implement safety strategy and policy
- Establishment and measurement of safety performance in the development, manufacturing and delivery of safety products and to take actions and activities if the targets are not met.
